The [Plan4Health Nashua project](#) is bringing the City of Nashua to the forefront as a leader in New Hampshire when it comes to advancing Complete Streets at the municipal level. The Plan4Health coalition developed an informational video to help demonstrate that people's ability to make healthy choices are improved when health and wellness are integrated into a comprehensive planning process.

The goal of the Plan4Health Nashua project is to advance street planning and design that support safer and easier ways to get around for pedestrians and bicyclists. The project is supported by the Greater Nashua Public Health Advisory Council, and was selected as a priority project for implementation in Nashua's 2015 Community Health Improvement Plan.
