During healthcare transitions, patients and their families are the constant. Engaging them in the plan of care reduces safety risks for the individual. Using this simple concept can be an effective strategy to improve the transition of care for the patient along the healthcare continuum. The discussion will include a case study review of the journey through the continuum for a stroke survivor and their family.
